

## **VILLAGE OF VOORHEESVILLE** **SPDES PERMIT PROCEDURES**

Site construction is subject to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) regulations. Projects will be required to be in conformance with the current SPDES General Permit for Stormwater Discharges from Construction Activity.

The current permit regulations, requirements and forms are available on the NYSDEC website: <https://www.dec.ny.gov/chemical/43133.html>

It is a requirement that all projects that have a site disturbance of one acre or more apply to receive coverage under the General Permit. A Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) is required to be prepared and submitted to the Village for review. The SWPPP and Best Management Practices must be consistent with the current New York State Stormwater Management Design Manual. Upon review and approval from the Village, a Notice of Intent (NOI) is prepared and along with the MS4 SWPPP Acceptance Form signed by the Village, is submitted to the NYSDEC.

The SWPPP and project design plans are subject to review by the Village of Voorheesville Planning Board.
